For young people with less opportunities

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What is the project about?

The MOVE project allows young people from Tours priority neighborhoods to volunteer in European Union (alone or in a group for a short and/or a long time) thanks to a strong personal assistance.

What are the goals for the young people?

- **To learn a foreign language**
- **To improve their employability**
- **To live a new experiment**
- **To discover others cultures and to meet new people**
- **To open young people mind about Europe**

What issues are we facing with the project?

During our meetings with young people, we identified several needs and expectations:

- A need of emancipation for the young people. They need to discover other cultures in order to get out of their daily routine, sometimes due to long time unemployment.
- The support for young people needs to be based on their motivation either than on their degrees.
- They find that it is indispensable to search their projects in a dynamic way.
- To speak English (or another European language) and benefit from a support in the writing of professional documents such as CV, motivation letter.
- Cultural and linguistic preparation before the departure.

FOCUS on employability after a voluntary

To volunteer in Europe substantially increase young people's employability and they develop:

- More skills
- A larger network
- Clearest vision of their professional future
- More confidence

Former volunteer's express that they reached a better job, higher salary and more responsibilities after finishing a volunteering service.

Who?

Young people between 18 and 30 years old (from disadvantaged areas of Tours, for the French group)

When?

30 September to 17 October 2018: Meeting with the partners, planning and organization of the workshops.

15 October to the end of November: Communication about the dates of the project

Beginning of November: Information Meetings in the French partner's organizations :

Information about European Volunteering + Workshop "Tools of mobility"	2h	Every week in 3 organizations	Helping young people find a mission, guide them thanks to online tools (European data base, PASS and Facebook groups) and help them to apply in English (CV Europass and cover letter in English)
Cultural and linguistic formation	1h30	Once a month in 3 organizations	Discover and learn about European cultures and languages in a funny way + prepare the departure of the young people.

Focus on the group volunteering

The group volunteering is one the most important aspect of the project. It is seen as a first experience of volunteering for young people before an eventual longer experience (in individual volunteering).

Informations about the volunteering:

Type of volunteering: Group volunteering in the frame of European solidarity corps

Duration: Around 1 month

Period: Summer 2019 (ideally in July)

Number of participants: 14

Nationalities: 10 French; 4 Spanish

Activity field: Environment, Culture, Sport (Ideally, but we are open to other activities)

Observations:

- French participants are Young with less opportunities (but they won't have deep issues).
- We follow and regularly see the future participants
- When the mission will be found, each participants will have to present a CV and a text explaining his/her motivation, both in English
- The group will be compose of men and women
- Participants will follow linguistic and cultural workshops before the departure, including a preparation for the volunteering.
